From the Pastor's Desk...

Dear Parish Family,

As we continue to pray for all those affected by Hurricane Katrina, we are invited to put our trust in the person of Jesus the Christ. The One who is able to lead us to the truth. As I mentioned last week in my homily, the time to know Him, is now. We have been given the opportunity to listen to Him as the One who is able to help us make sense out of life and all that this disaster represents.

This is only possible when we take the time to open our minds and hearts to His words in the Scriptures and in the Eucharist. He says, ***I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through me*** (Jn 14:6). He has come from the Father to lead us to the Father. Jesus came with a mission; He came to share with us the divine life. In this we can put our trust because God has an ultimate purpose for us - eternal life.

This week we are again challenged by the scriptures to forgive from our heart, to receive God's mercy, (The Sacrament of Reconciliation is a grace-filled way to do this), to ***remember death...to cease from sin***. And, we are comforted as we pray in the Responsorial Psalm: ***The Lord is kind and merciful, slow to anger and rich in compassion***. The psalmist continues: ***He pardons all your (our) iniquities, heals all your (our) ills, redeems your (our) life from destruction, crowns you (us) with kindness and compassion***. What wonderful, consoling promises of our loving God!

The ability to forgive begins with our understanding and belief in the limitless mercy and love of God. Furthermore, the church teaches that the baptized, having experienced this mercy and forgiveness through the redemption of Jesus, are expected and commanded to forgive one another. In today's reading, Sirach says: ***Forgive your neighbor's injustice; then when you pray, your own sins, will be forgiven***. Jesus instructed his disciples and us to pray: ***Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us***. The ability to forgive builds community.

With God's help and a team of generous, willing parishioners, we are continuing our stewardship renewal process which is now ongoing. Stewardship renewal of our talents and treasures, involves all members of the parish community because it is the parish that we uniquely experience Church and live out our Catholic commitment. We ask for your prayers, your support and the continuous witness of your faith here at Our Lady of Lourdes. May the Holy Spirit guide and inspire us all!!

And finally, no matter what may have transpired these past couple of weeks here at home and in the Gulf ports, and within our individual lives when we turn to the Lord we discover that there is a purpose - eternal life. Have a blessed week.

Querida familia parroquial:

Al continuar nuestras oraciones por todos aquellos afectados por el huracán Katrina, nos sentimos invitados a depositar nuestra confianza en la persona de Jesucristo, Él es el único capaz de guiarnos a la verdad. Tal y como les mencioné en mi homilía de la pasada semana, el tiempo de conocerle es ahora. Se nos ha dado la oportunidad de escucharle como el único capaz de ayudarnos a darle sentido a la vida y a todo este desastre.

Esto es posible tan solo si abrimos nuestras mentes y corazones a Su palabra en las escrituras y en la Eucaristía. Él dijo: *"Yo soy el camino, la verdad y la vida; nadie viene al Padre sino por mí"*. (Jn. 14:6) Él ha venido del Padre para llevarnos al Padre. Jesús vino con una misión; Él vino a compartir con nosotros la vida divina. En esto debemos poner nuestra confianza porque Dios tiene un propósito para nosotros -la vida eterna-.

En las lecturas de esta semana se nos insta una vez más a perdonar de corazón, a recibir la misericordia de Dios (el sacramento de la Reconciliación es una forma llena de gracias para lograr esto). El Salmo responsorial nos reconforta: *"El Señor es compasivo y misericordioso, lento a la ira y rico en misericordia"*. El salmista continua: *Él perdona todas tus culpas y cura todas tus enfermedades; Él rescata tu vida de la fosa y te colma de gracia y de ternura"*. ¡Qué maravillosa y consoladora promesa de Dios!

La habilidad de perdonar comienza con nuestro modo de enfrentar y creer en la ilimitada misericordia y amor de Dios. Más aun, la iglesia nos enseña que todo bautizado, habiendo experimentado la misericordia y perdón mediante la redención de Jesús, está obligado a perdonar a los demás. En la primera lectura del Eclesiástico se nos dice: *"Perdona la ofensa a tu prójimo, y así, cuando pidas perdón se te perdonarán tus pecados"*. Jesús enseña a orar a Sus discípulos y a nosotros: *"Perdona nuestras ofensas, como también nosotros perdonamos a los que nos ofenden"*. La habilidad de perdonar construye comunidades.

Con la ayuda de Dios y un grupo de generosos y dispuestos parroquianos continuamos hoy nuestro proceso renovador de mayordomía. Esta renovación de mayordomía de nuestros talentos y tesoros involucra a todos los miembros de la comunidad parroquial porque es en la parroquia donde experimentamos la Iglesia y vivimos nuestro compromiso católico. Pedimos sus oraciones, su apoyo y el continuo testimonio de vuestra fe aquí en Nuestra Señora de Lourdes. ¡Que el Espíritu Santo nos guie e inspire a todos!

Y finalmente, no importa lo sucedido en estas semanas pasadas, ya sea aquí en casa o en el Golfo, cuando nos volvemos al Señor descubrimos que hay un propósito - la vida eterna -.

¡Que tengan una semana llena de bendiciones!
