## From the Pastor's Desk...

Dear Parish Family,

Every Sunday (or Saturday evening) the people of God will gather in prayer. They are spiritually nourished by the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. There is a danger that we treat the Scripture readings as we often do with a newspaper or a magazine that is, quickly rushing through and glancing at the headlines. The Scriptures demand more time, more reflection and prayer. There is always a message for us from God. The priest in his homily will try to focus on some aspects of the readings. In such a short time he can never exhaust the many inspiring thoughts that are found in each reading. I have met families who take this approach. After Mass as the family is driving home, or better yet, when the family will gather for their Sunday meal, they discuss what they heard Father speak about, or some thought or phrase from one of the readings, or from a hymn sung at the Mass, or from some prayer of the Mass that caught their attention.

It is amazing to listen to the insights of the children. The family is communicating with one another. There is sharing, listening, learning, praying, growing closer to God. After all, who are the **FIRST** and **BEST** teachers of the children? of course, Mom and Dad. Let us take some examples from today's readings. The first reading is from Ezeckiel. Who is he? One of the children could look that up in the Bible. In that first reading God is talking to His people and says, **Hear now, House of Israel: is it my way that is unfair, or rather, are not your ways unfair?** This could develop into a discussion among family members how at times we do not treat God fairly! Or in the second reading we are reminded not to be selfish; **humbly regard others as more important than yourselves, each looking out not for his own interests, but also for those of others.** What a powerful and reflective lesson for every family. In every Mass we find so many enriching thoughts for discussion, which will help to bring a family closer to each other and to God. Give it a try each Sunday.

## Del Escritorio del Párroco

Querida familia parroquial:

Cada domingo (o sábado en la tarde) el pueblo de Dios se reúne en oración para alimentarnos espiritualmente por medio de la liturgia de la palabra y la liturgia de la Eucaristía. Pero existe un peligro, que hagamos de las Escrituras como si se tratara de la lectura de un periódico o una revista, deteniéndonos solamente en los titulares. Las Escrituras demandan mucho más tiempo, más reflexión y oración. Ellas siempre nos traen un mensaje de Dios.

El sacerdote en sus homilias trata siempre de hablarnos acerca de alguno de los aspectos de las lecturas, pero en tan poco tiempo él no puede hacer una explicación detallada de todos los pensamientos llenos de inspiración que contiene cada lectura. Conozco algunas familias que en su regreso a casa, o mejor aun, cuando se reúnen como familia para la comida dominical, discuten lo que han escuchado decir al sacerdote, o alguna frase o pensamiento proveniente de las lecturas, o tal vez algún himno cantado en la misa, o cualquier oración dicha y que ha captado la atención de todos.

Es impresionante escuchar los pensamientos de algunos niños. La familia comunicándose entre sí. El compartir, escucharse unos a otros, aprender, orar, crecer juntos en la presencia de Dios. Después de todo, ¿quienes son los primeros maestros de los niños? por supuesto que mamá y papá.

Saquemos algunos ejemplos de las lecturas de hoy. La primera lectura tomada de Ezequiel. ¿Quién era él? Alguno de los niños podría buscar en la Biblia. En esta primera lectura Dios habla a su pueblo y le dice: "*Escucha, casa de Israel: ¿Conque es injusto mi proceder? ¿no es más bien el proceder de ustedes el injusto?*" Este pasaje pudiera llevar a la familia a pensar las veces que no somos justos con Dios. En la segunda lectura se nos recuerda que no debemos ser egoístas, *sino que debemos considerar a los demás como superiores a sí mismo y no busque su propio interés, sino el del prójimo.* ¡Qué poderoso mensaje y que lleno de reflexión esta lección para toda familia! En cada misa encontramos tanto que nos enriquece, pensamientos para discusión y que nos ayudan a hacer que cada día la familia esté más unida entre sí y a Dios. ¿Por qué no lo prueban cada domingo?

¡Que tengan una maravillosa semana!
