"Respect Life" concerns not only conception and death issues, but also issues of poverty, racism, capital punishment...all issues that center on how human life is treated, how human beings are allowed to live.

As we approach the end of the Year of the Eucharist, we thank God for the blessings we have received and pray for the needs of our society so that justice and peace will be there for us and for all people.

Please make it an effort this month to do your part- your participation in this very important issue is reinforced and strengthened with prayer, especially before the Blessed Sacrament.
